### Our Future Ministry in Haiti is Expanding

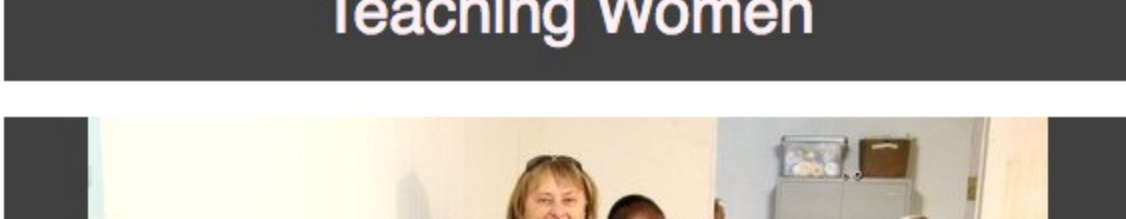

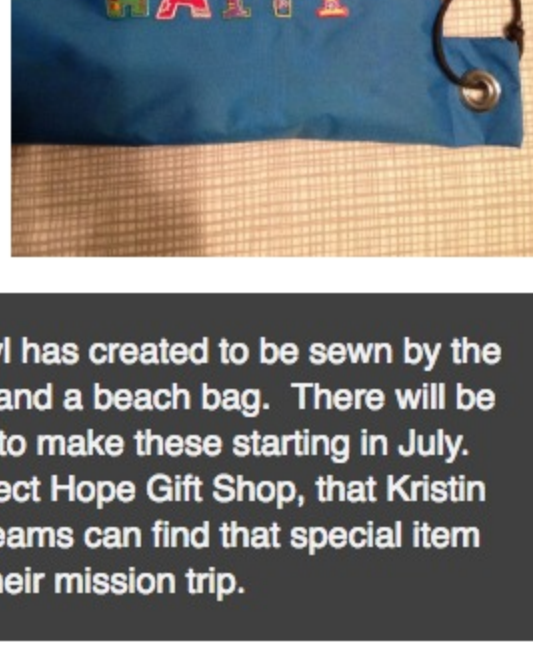
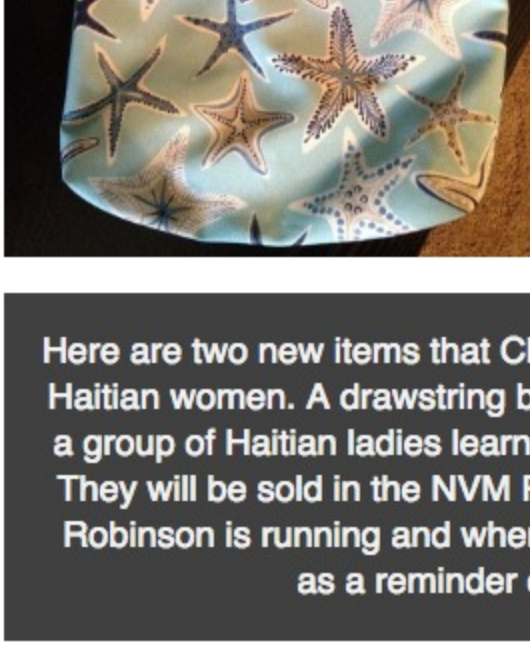
### Teaching Women

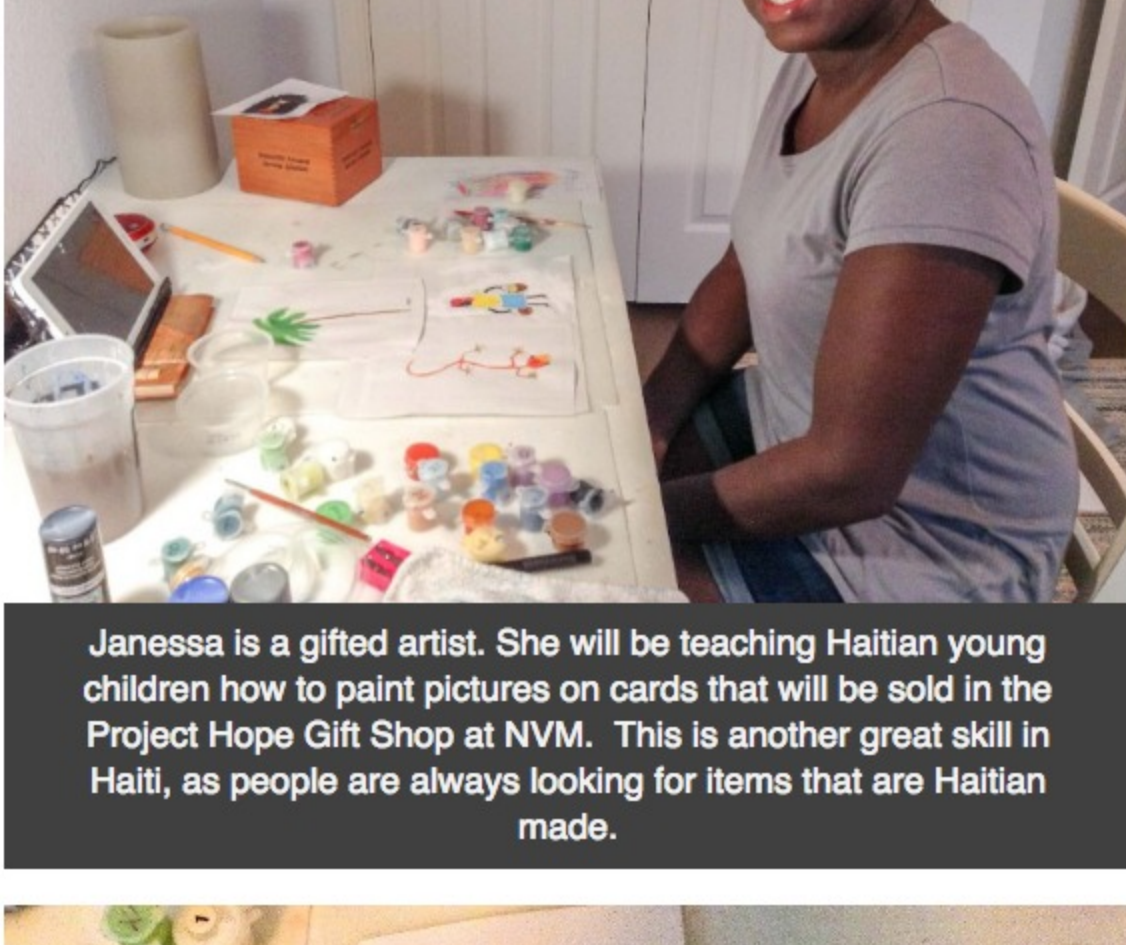

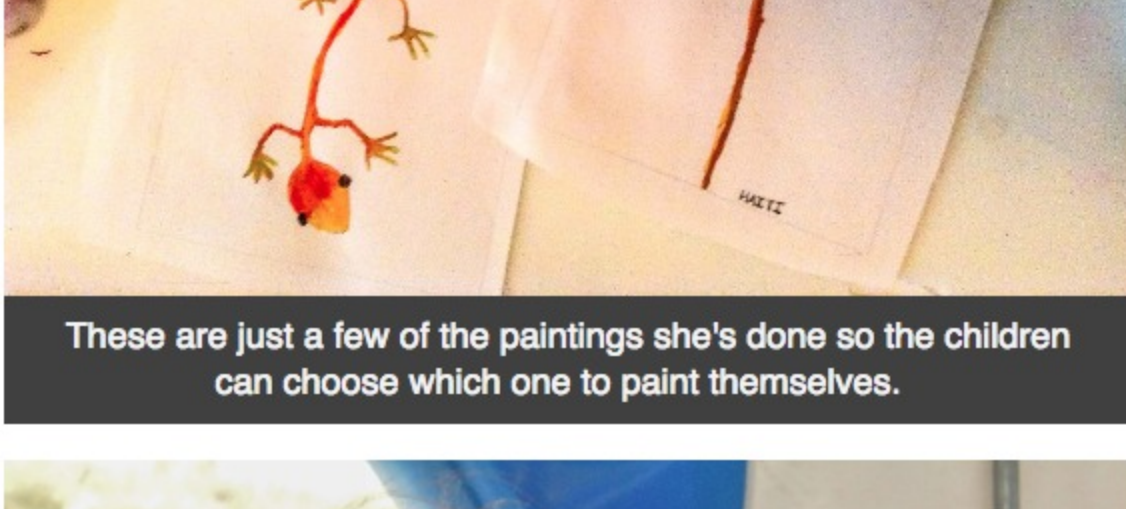
### Jamie & Janessa



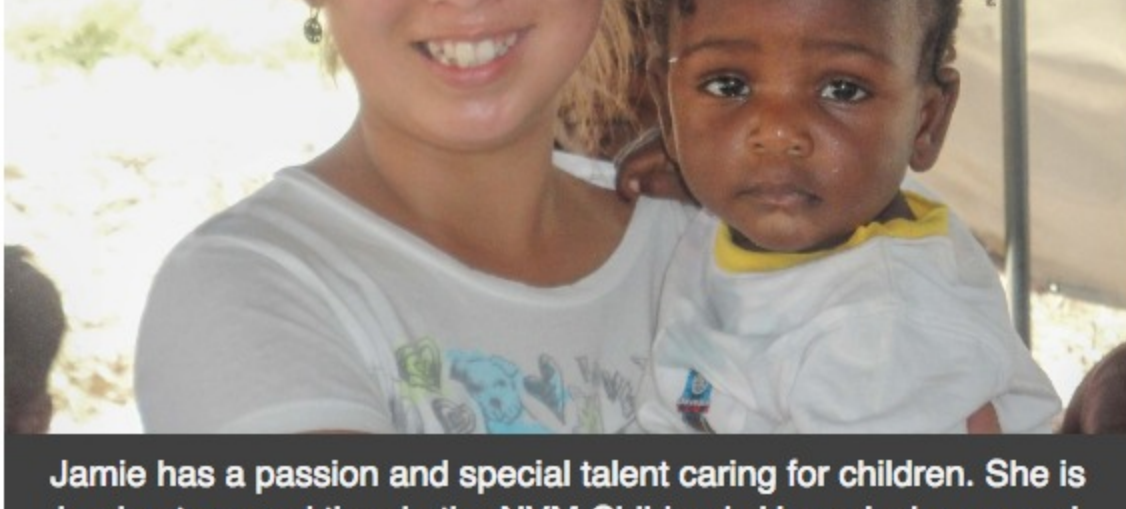
